Denomination of origin: Ribera del Duero.

Type of Wine: Barrel-aged red wine.

Variety: 100% Tinta fina (Tempranillo).

Origin: Roa (Burgos, Spain).

Production: 6.500 bottles.

Vintage: 2014.

Alcohol: 14,5%.

Vineyard: 36 Ha.

Ageing: 21 months in french and american oak barrels.

Winemaking: Temperature controlled fermentation between 25-27°C. Long maceration seeking maximum extraction of polyphenols for a wine with long bottle life.

TASTING NOTES

Colour: Intense ruby red color with ruby edge.

Aroma: Deep and complex. Fruits, black currant, with a hint of raspberry, coffee, toffee and vanilla. Good balance between wood and fruit.

Taste: Complex and full, round, full bodied. Long, rounded palate. Ripe fruit, licorice and toasty notes.

Service temperature: 14-16°C.
