

TORREPINGÓN ROBLE 2019



- Varieties: 90% Tempranillo, 10% Cabernet Sauvignon
- Appellation: Ribera del Duero
- Alcohol: 14,5 % vol.
- Type of wine: Tinto Roble (Red wine)
- Ageing time: 3 months in American and French oak barrels
- Colour: Black cherry red with violet undertones
- Nose: Very potent with hints of ripe red fruit (berries, blackberries, raspberries) blended with light, subtle and very suggestive tones of spice. This is a terrific example of a very sociable Spanish 'young wine': not too full-bodied but with a hint of oak (*roble*), brisk tannins and concentrated flavours of mulberry, raspberry and clove from a blend of Tempranillo and Cabernet Sauvignon.
- Mouth: Well structured, balanced and full of flavour. It offers the tannins of its middle vintage. It is long-lasting and the finish strongly recalls the red fruits. Easy-drinking wine.
- Gastronomy: Drink with a plate of ham or tapas as though you were in Spain, or let its gentle oak flavours partner meat or vegetable dishes as a crowd-pleasing quaffer.
- Serving Temperature: 16 °C to 18 °C.
- Packaging: 6 bottle case.
